- Violin, viola, cello, and bass
- **Junior division**- Middle School student presently in grades 5,6,7, or 8
- **Senior division**-High School students presently in grades 9,10,11 or 12
- A panel of distinguished musicians will serve as judges for the competition.
- All applicants must submit the following **on or before May 12<sup>th</sup>**:
  - Send via email, a **pre-screen video recording** to be admitted to the **final round** of competition. Preferred are emailed links to youtube video but recordings may also be sent via dropbox. We strongly urge you to perform with an accompanist on this recording.
  - Mail the **application and fee of \$30** to Julie Ribchinsky, postmarked by **May 12<sup>th</sup>**.
- **Twelve finalists** will be invited to CCSU to perform in the final round of competition on Sunday, June 3<sup>rd</sup> beginning at 3:00 P.M. This is a public performance.
- Awards will be announced at the conclusion of all performances. Prizes are as follows: **Senior Division winner \$500, Second place \$200, Junior Division winner \$100, Second place \$50.**
- An accompanist will be available (or applicant may supply your own). Contestants will have the opportunity to rehearse for 15 minutes, to be scheduled on June 3, prior to the competition. The competition begins at 3:00 P.M.

- Repertoire must include no more than 12 minutes of music selected as follows:
- Junior Division: Two contrasting works. One must be from the Baroque period.
- Senior Division: Two contrasting works. One must be a from the solo Bach repertoire.

The final round of competition is free and open to public. Donations for student scholarship awards will be gratefully accepted. **Checks made payable to CT-ASTA.**
